Pseudonymous use of the website

You can generally use our Internet pages without informing us of any personified data. Pseudonymous usage data are not matched with the data of the bearer of the pseudonym. Pseudonymous usage profiles are not created.

Special functions of the website

Our website offers you various functions during the use of which we collect, process and store personal data. In the following we explain what happens to this data:

Contact form

We only use the data collected via the contact form for processing enquiries submitted using the contact form. After processing of the enquiry, any collected data are deleted within six months.

Data transfer / credit assessment and scoring / other purposes

We only transfer the data (e.g. name and address) necessary for us to fulfil our contractual obligation and for third parties to guarantee a smooth process, especially for processing of a concluded contract or when storage of the data is required for other statutory reasons. When you make personal data available to us, these data are only used for the purpose that you have consented to prior to entry of the data. We shall only store these data as necessary for the intended purpose of the data collection or as required by law.

In the event that we have to offer advance services, we reserve our right to safeguard our legitimate interests and obtain a credit check on the basis of mathematical and statistical rating from a business services provider. For this purpose we transfer the personal data required for a credit check to a third party and use the obtained data on the statistical probability of nonpayment for a considered decision on the justification, execution or termination of the contract. The credit information can include probabilities (scores) calculated on the basis of scientifically acknowledged mathematical and statistical methods and in the calculation of which. for example, address data are included. Your legitimate interests are handled in accordance with legal requirements. You can obtain information on data stored concerning you from the respective body. Apart from the abovementioned purposes of creditworthiness checks, contract and payment processing, your data are not passed on to a third party.

Statistical evaluation of visits to this website

We collect, process and store on visits to this website or individual files of this website the following data: IP address, website from which the file is requested, name of the file, data and time of the request, volume of data transferred and reports on the success of the request (web logs). We use these access data exclusively in



non-personalized form for ongoing improvement of our web pages and for statistical purposes.

Information about the use of cookies
